If you have warm-up clothes that you don't wish to run with, a "sweats" drop off will be provided for your convenience at the Museum near the starting line. This will be available only until 6:25 pm. Simply place your sweats in a bag that will have your number on it, and leave it at the drop off area. The bags will be transported to the finish line area in Veteran's Park, and you can pick yours up by showing your race number. (With the weather, however, you may not want to run without your sweats!)

Runners/Walkers under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Make checks payable to: Klamath Union High School.. All proceeds will go to the Klamath Union XC and track teams.
